Purpose: You are probably aware of recent changes to the European Machinery Directive (2006/42/EC), which governs the design and manufacture of powered access products.

This led us to review our product range, and as a result of this review we have identified a change to the maximum platform load rating of the MB20 and MB26, in terms of the number of persons loading, and we have decided that it would be appropriate to backdate the changes shown below:-

- MB20 Number of persons platform load rating is changed from (2 persons plus tools indoors and 2 persons plus tools outdoors) to (2 persons plus tools, indoor only)
- MB26N Number of persons platform load rating is changed from (2 persons plus tools indoor and 2 persons plus tools outdoors) to (2 persons plus tools indoors and 1 person plus tools outdoors)

The above changes should be implemented for machines shown in the serial ranges above.
